GUIDELINE MODIFICATIONS

- Judge questions have been removed; terminology has been changed from “interview with judges” to “presentation for judges;” and portfolio copies and lamination requirements have been removed from the modified rubric.
- Competitors will record a video of their presentation for judges.
- Competitors will also upload a copy of their portfolio.
- Competitors will upload: 1) Video of their presentation; and 2) Portfolio
- Uploads must be completed by April 12 at 6:00pm. The uploaded materials are what the judges will use to score competitors.
- If you do not upload your materials, there is no content to be judged, therefore no score will be given. Judges will receive materials on April 13, so if you miss the April 12 upload deadline your material will not be sent to judges.
- Pro Tip: Don’t wait until the last day to upload! Try to upload your materials before the deadline. If something goes wrong, you have time to troubleshoot!

TECHNOLOGY NEEDS

- Students will need to upload their materials to the online competitive event portal (Cognito) – a smartphone, tablet, or computer are needed to upload.
