Building Bridges: Exploring the Benefits of Volunteering and Community Collaboration

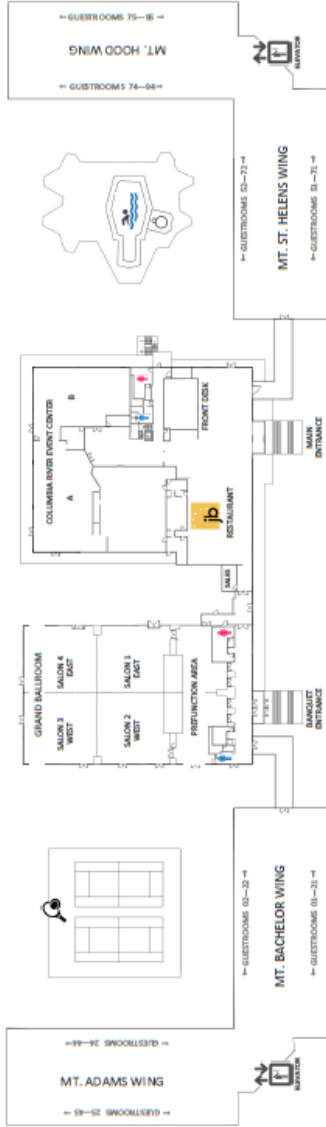
