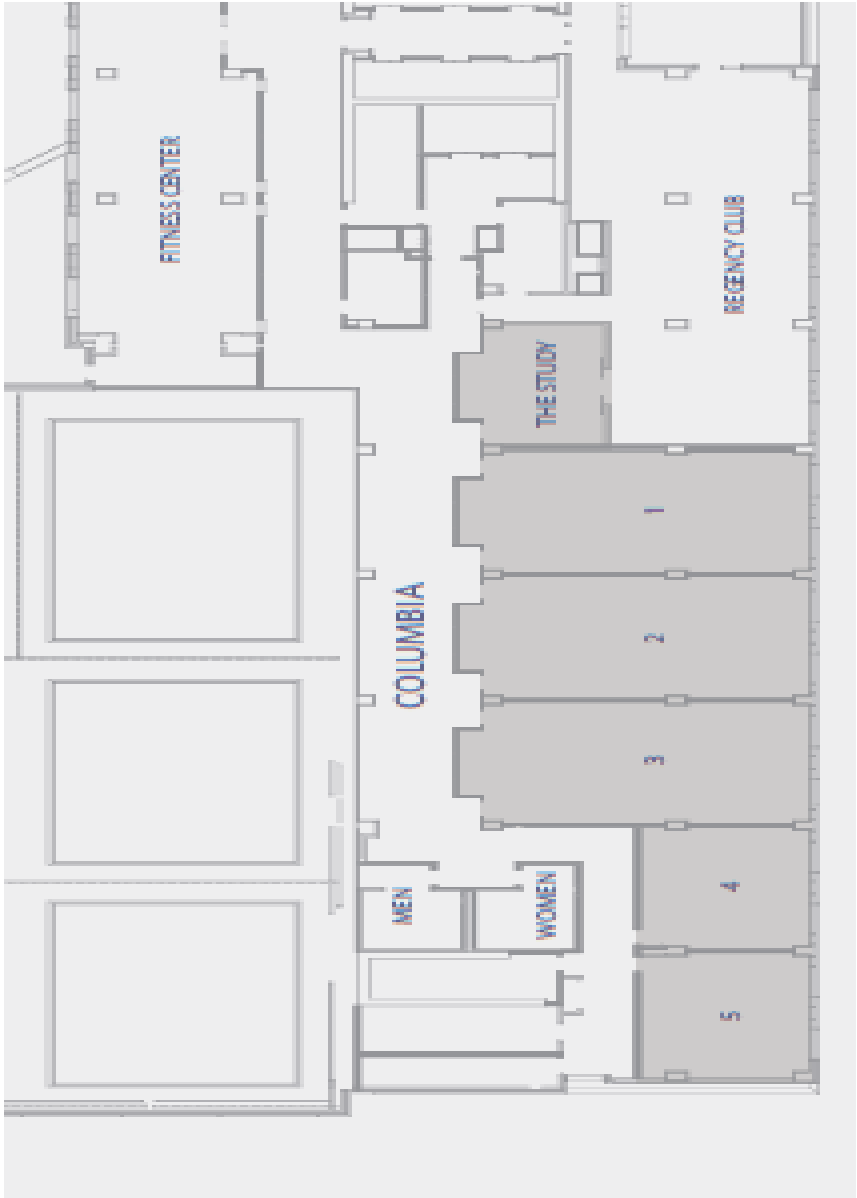
Hotel Map: Level One
