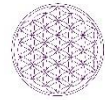

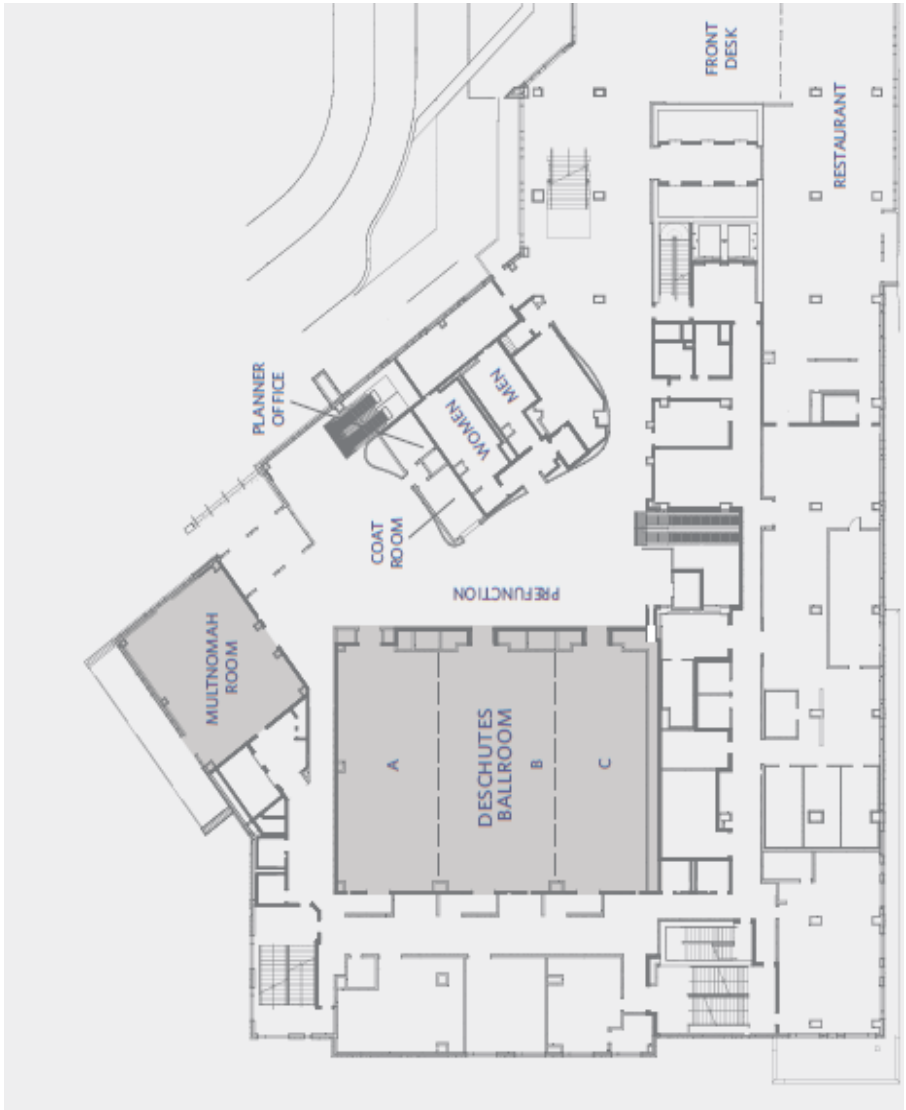


KEYNOTE ADDRESS

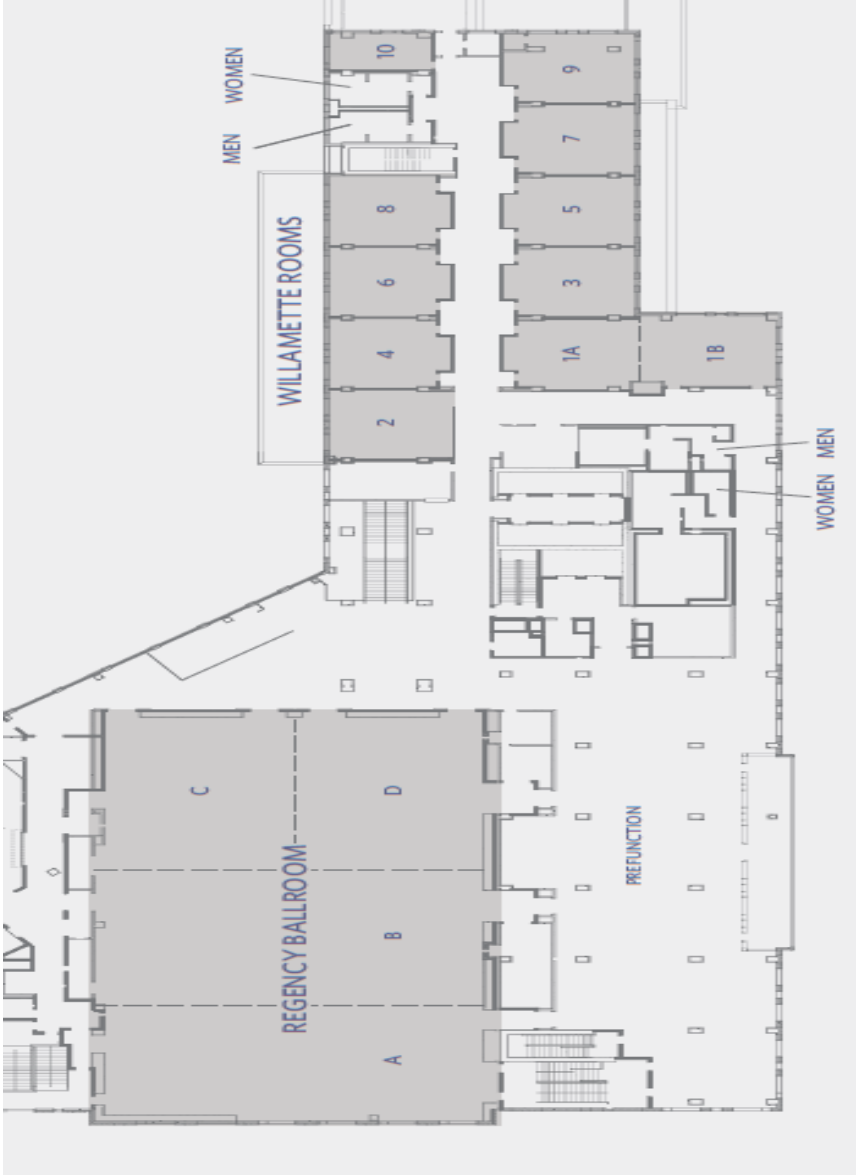

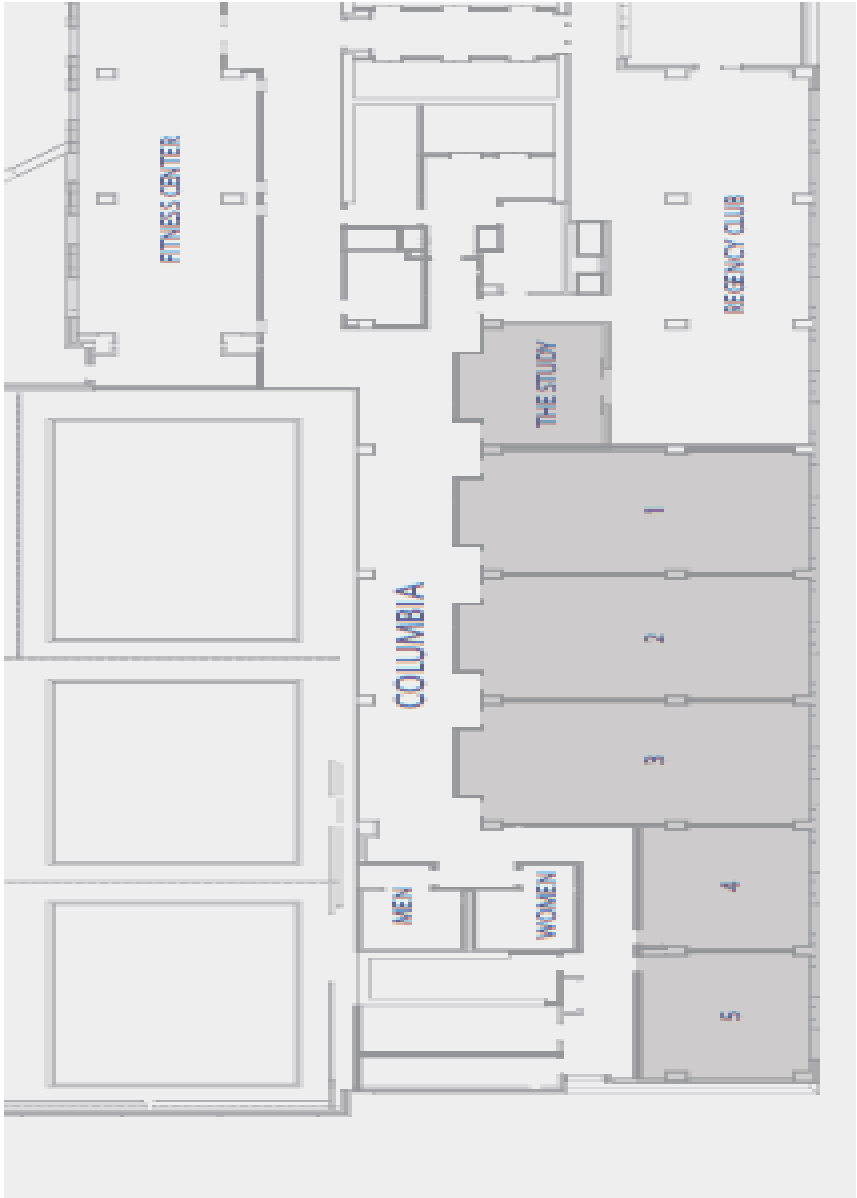
Hotel Map: Level One
